WHAT IS NWI?

NWI is a scholarship program offered to UAB employees who wish to complete their degree in Nursing at Wallace State Community College.

DO I QUALIFY?

- Minimum 1 consecutive year of service (at least 6 mo. full time).
- No disciplinary action in the previous 12 months
- Agreement to work full-time while taking classes and maintain satisfactory school requirements.

CLASS OPTIONS?

All general education courses are offered on-campus and virtually. Nursing courses are offered at the main campus in Hanceville and at the Oneonta Center. Nursing courses are offered in a hybrid format with a minimum 2 days on campus for labs, simulation, and testing.

WHAT ABOUT WORK?

You will need to maintain full-time status. You can supplement your hours working as a Patient Observer through NSSP.

LPN 2 years


